40 Days for Life Campaign

February 22 to April 1, 2012

Parishioners throughout the Cedar Rapids area are urged to participate in the 40 Days for Life Campaign from February 22 to April 1. The purpose of this International Campaign is to end the grave evil of Abortion by: 1) personal or group prayer and fasting; 2) participation in the peaceful prayer vigil outside of Planned Parenthood in Cedar Rapids; and 3) community education. Cardinal George, Archbishop of Chicago, and Cardinal DiNardo, Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston have endorsed this Campaign.

Cardinal George said *"The Gospel message calls us to conversion and to defend life. We must all work to answer God's call. This peaceful, 40 days fasting effort gives local Catholics ample opportunity to join with people of faith around the country in doing something significant to help put an end to abortion. I encourage members of our local Church to participate in this important national event."*

This is a special time to pray for:

- 1) the unborn;
- 2) couples with an unplanned pregnancy;
- 3) healing for mothers and fathers who have had an abortion;
- 4) a conversion of heart for those working in the abortion industry; and
- 5) parishioners who oppose abortion but are fearful of getting involved.
